Learned	Response
<p><b>1</b>     <b>WARNING:</b> “Due to COVID-19 pandemic, please use caution when interpreting scores and ratings on 2020-2021 report cards.”</p>	<p>Last year matters to the lives of our children. Why did District perform worse than State average?</p>
<p><b>2</b>     You can’t just look at single years’ result. Must be 3-year average. <b>(Achievement Score)</b></p>	<p>Child receives “F” and says don’t worry, my 3 year average is a “B”</p>
<p><b>3</b>     The State lowered the lower thresholds for the Overall Ratings <b>(Fully Meets lowered from 63 to 58)</b></p>	<p>DPI touts: In ‘18-’19, 96% of Districts at Fully Meet or above, and 95% in ‘20 -’21! <b>SECRET: 85% did in ‘20-’21 at previous threshold</b></p>
<p><b>4</b>     Benchmark your District against the State</p>	<p>Just as people are benchmarked against each other (e.g. Bell Curve)</p>
<p><b>5</b>     Low scores due to low spend/pupil or lower income per district</p>	<p>In Rock County, WEAK correlation for both</p>

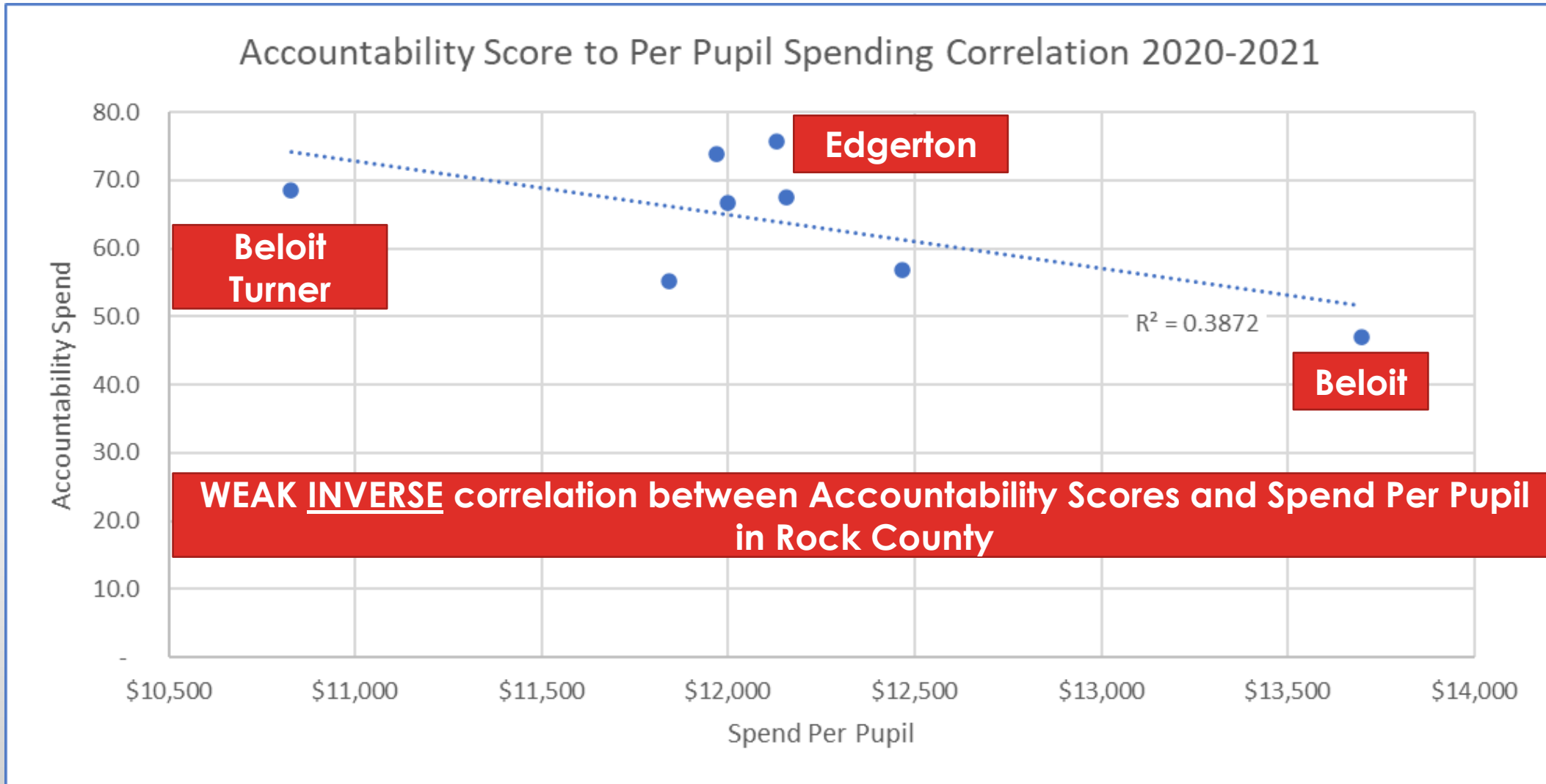
